Maths

This half term in maths we will be focussing on...

Calculations—Addition and Subtraction within 20

Multiplication and Division

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2,5 and 10 multiplication tables.
- Be able to recognise odd and even numbers.
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division, using materials, arrays and repeated addition.

Fractions

- Recognise, find and write halves and quarters

Science

We will be learning about seasons. We have been learning about the 4 seasons and will be doing some experiments to observe different types of weathers.
