Our learning will be centred around **Ancient Egypt** this half term.

# History and Geography

In History, we will be learning about Ancient Egypt. We will investigate the main beliefs of Ancient Egyptians. The children will be thinking about how these beliefs shaped their daily lives. We will focus on how and why the Ancient Egyptian civilisation was so successful, considering significant pharaohs and their legacy. In addition, we will investigate Ancient Egyptian monuments, gods and beliefs about mummification and life after death. As well as this, we will explore the importance of artefacts and what they tell us about the past.

## Reading

This half term we will be reading 'Ancient Egypt Sleepover' by Stephen Davies as our class reader. We will practise our summarising skills by identifying the main events from what we have read and completing summaries in our reading logs. It is a book full of mystery and adventure that will help inspire our writing.

Our reading lessons will focus on a range of reading skills including:

- Finding information in the text

- Understanding new vocabulary in context and considering why an author uses these words
- Using clues from the text to work out the feelings of characters
- Making predictions about what will happen next

## Writing

Our writing units this half term will be based around our topic of Ancient Egypt and the book 'Ancient Egypt Sleepover' by Stephen Davies. Using this text, the children will write their own mystery story (based on a night in a museum), a non-chronological report based on the lifestyle and beliefs of Ancient Egyptians and a persuasive argument linked to artefacts and where they should be kept.

During these units, the pupils will focus on using brackets for parenthesis to add additional information to their writing. For example,

Ancient Egyptian monuments (such as the Sphinx and the Great Pyramids) still stand today.

# Campaign

Our class campaign this term is linked to 'Keep Connected.' We will be learning about artefacts and how they are used to inform us about the past. We will consider whether we believe artefacts should be kept in their original countries or in notable museums such as 'The British Museum' and present balanced arguments based on our findings.

## Science

Our science topic this half term will be 'Properties of Materials.' We will explore the different properties of a range of materials including whether they are magnetic or not and their hardness. We will investigate whether materials are transparent, translucent or opaque. In addition, we will explore a material's ability to conduct electricity and insulate heat.

We will develop our scientific skills by recording our results and observations and drawing conclusions. We will plan investigations and evaluate them this half term.

## **ICT**

Our topic this half term is 'Programming- Selection in Physical Computing.' We will develop our understanding of programming and the components it requires. In addition, we will introduce conditions and see how these conditions influence our algorithms.

### **PSHE**

This half term our PSHE unit is 'Dreams and Goals.' During this topic, the children will think about jobs and careers and what they want to be when they grow up. We will think about the steps we will need to take to be successful and compare our goals with children from other cultures, considering how we can support each other to be successful.

### RE

Our focus religion this half term is Sikhism. Our key question is 'How far would a Sikh go for their religion?' We will learn about Sikh religious practices and beliefs.

### PE

PE lessons this half term will focus on NFL Flag.

## Music

The children will be exploring rock music and will be learning the song 'Livin' on a Prayer.' Throughout the topic they will be exploring how to use musical vocabulary accurately e.g. tempo (speed), volume and rhythm.

# Spanish

In Spanish, our focus for this half term is 'Food.' The children will learn how to say and write a range of foods in Spanish and will also learn about piñatas.

## Art and DT

This half term in DT, the children will learn about pulleys and gears and use this knowledge to create their own cranes.
