Our learning will be centred around **Clothes** this term.

History and Geography

In History, we will be learning about clothes. We will explore how the weather impacts the choice of clothing that we make and different clothes through different eras. We will learn about the Viking, Victorian and Tudor eras and the clothes that were worn and we will draw comparisons. We will also explore how clothes were made in the past compared to how clothes are made currently and we will have the chance to explore further when we visit the V&A clothes museum in a few weeks!

Reading

This half term we will continue to do phonics, with the focus of coming off the phonics programme by Christmas time.

Our writing units this half term will be based around our topic of Clothes and the book 'The Smartest Giant in Town.' Using this text, the children will write a retell using their own words. During this unit, the pupils will be focusing on using exclamation sentences in their writing. For example:

Multiplication and division- using mental and written strategies to multiply and divide within the 2 5 and 10s timetables.

Length- measuring and comparing the lengths of different items using metres and centimetres.

Mass- measuring and comparing the mass of different items using grams and kilograms.

Campaign

Science

Our Science topic this half term will be 'Materials'. We will explore different materials and their properties.

We will develop our scientific skills by planning our investigations, selecting our equipment, recording our results and observations, drawing conclusions and evaluating the accuracy of our investigation and results.

Our topic this half term is 'Creating media.' We will develop our understanding of using technology to create digital photography. We will use digital devices to create and edit digital images. We will use a range of devices, such as tablets, webcams and cameras to take photographs and different editing programmes and apps to edit these.

PSHE

This half term our PSHE unit is 'celebrating difference'. During this topic, the children will think about and discuss how everyone is different from one another. We will also learn about using kind words to help others to feel welcome and what to do when someone is being bullied.

RE

Our focus religion this half term is Judaism. Our key question is 'What values does Hanukkah teach?'
