History and Geography

Writing

Our writing units this half term are based around the Romans and Roman Myths. We will be writing a non-chronological report based on the Romans and we will be retelling the story behind a Roman myth.

Maths

This half term we will be covering:

Place Value: We will learn to recognise and represent numbers to 10,000, round numbers, order and compare and read Roman numerals.

Addition and Subtraction: We will carry out calculations involving addition and subtractions. Using efficient methods, we will focus on 4 digit numbers which involves exchanges.

Trips and Visits

Friday 4th October- The British Museum to explore our topic of The Romans.

.Campaign

Our class campaign this term is linked to 'Keep Green.'

Science

The focus of our Science lessons this half term will be: **Animals Including Humans**

We will investigate different types of Animals, including humans. We will also learn about different parts of the human body and their functions in everyday life, particularly the role of the digestive system.

ICT

Our topic this half term is 'Systems and Searching.' We will develop our understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices. We will learn how search engines work and compare different search engines.

PSHE

This half term our PSHE unit is 'Being me in my World.' During this topic, the children will think about and discuss the year ahead, goals they can set for themselves and challenges they may face. They will learn and talk about their rights and responsibilities as a member of their class, school, wider community and the country they live in.

RE

Our focus religion this half term is Judaism. We will learn about the key figures in the religion, the values of Hanukkah and stories and teachings from the Jewish tradition.

PΕ

PE lessons this half term will focus on dance, gymnastics and yoga. Please ensure that your child comes to school dressed in their PE kit **Tuesday.**

Music

The children will be exploring Gospel music this half term. They will identify musical dimensions featured in a song. They will perform using the glockenspiel. They will be able to express their understanding using key vocabulary including tempo, notation and rhythm.

Spanish

The theme of this half term's Spanish lessons is 'All About Me'. Children will focus on expressing information about themselves, their families and heritage.. Using sentence builders, children will be able to express information including who their family members are and their ages.

Art and DT

In Art, children will create mosaics inspired by their Romans History topic. They will analyse the styles and colours used in Roman mosaics before creating their own. Look out for the fantastic work on Instagram.
