Our learning will be centred around this term.

## History and Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about The Seven Wonders of the World. We will locate these wonders in an atlas using our knowledge of lines of longitude and latitude. We will work to create a travel guide about three of these

## Reading

This half term we will be reading Epic Fails by Erik Slader as our class reader. We will practise our summarising skills by identifying the main events from what we have read and completing summaries in our reading logs. It is a book full of historical failures!

Our reading lessons will focus on a range of reading skills including:

- Finding information in the text
- Understanding new vocabulary in context and considering why an author uses these words
- Using clues from the text to work out the feelings of characters
- Making predictions about what will happen next

### Writing

This unit is linked to our geography unit and the theme of flight. The Wright brothers trialled many ways of flying before eventually taking flight. Children are invited to trial a range of ways to make an egg fly and then write a scientific report based on their findings. They are then invited to use their trials and tribulations to write a humorous story based on the Epic Fails of their egg-cellent discovery. Children will be taught how to use homophones for humorous effect and how to use their failures as examples of how 'not to' do things, with eventual success. The children will then write a newspaper article based on the Wright brothers first flight.

#### Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be covering:

**Multiplication and Division-** using mental and written strategies to multiply by one and two digit numbers. In addition, we will learn about factors, multiples and prime numbers.

**Graphs**- we will learn how to draw and read picture graphs, bar charts and line graphs.

**Fractions-** we will learn how to write mixed fractions and how to show them on a number line. We will also find equivalent and improper fractions. Finally we will solve word problems that involve fractions.

## Campaign
