Our learning will be centred around **Toys** this term.

History and Geography

This term year 1 will be learning about toys. They will be learning about toys from the past as well as from the present. They will be comparing the materials and the uses of toys throughout history.

Reading

In year 1, we use the RWI programme to support reading. To support your child at home, please read with your child as often as you can. This can include them being read to as well as listening to them read. Please leave a comment in their yellow reading log when you have read with your child.

Writing

Our writing units this half term are based around our topic of toys. We will be using Dogger by Shirley Hughes to inspire our story writing. Narrative—Retelling the story of Dogger using our experiences of our favourite toys.

Maths

Subtraction within 10 - subtraction by crossing out, subtraction by counting back, making subtraction stories.

Positions - using positional language, naming positions in queues, naming left and write positions.

Numbers to 20 - counting to 20, writing numbers to 20, comparing numbers, ordering numbers.
